Jim – I reviewed this inspection report this morning and I'm hoping you can clarify some things for us. I filed the supplemental spill report with the initial report on September 2nd and you approved it on September 3rd. It would appear that at least in regards to the supplemental spill report there was no action required at the time of inspection because it had already been completed. If you are looking for something other than the supplemental report we have already filed, please let me know.

In regards to the cleanup itself, we are working on the overall final reclaim of the facility and once I've got confirmation that the contaminated soils have been excavated and removed from location we will have Olsson Associates collect confirmation samples. That should occur later this week although I have yet to visit with Olsson on their staff availability.
