POTENTIAL HAZARDS

FIRE OR EXPLOSION

Extremely flammable; may be ignited by heat, sparks, or flames. May be a gas due to its volatile components and fuel gases. Condensate may explode or burn if not properly contained. Condensate may be a gas due to its volatile components and fuel gases.

HEALTH HAZARDS

May be poisonous if inhaled or ingested. May be irritating to the eyes, nose, throat, and skin. May be a gas due to its volatile components and fuel gases. Condensate may be a gas due to its volatile components and fuel gases.

EMERGENCY ACTION

Wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and protective clothing. Only trained and equipped personnel should attempt. Provide ventilation and containment for vapors. If CMAA is not available, follow the instructions on the label for the product. Provide for the safe disposal of the material.

PIRE

Small fires:

Use dry chemical or CO₂.

Large fires:

Remove from area.

Move containers from the area if you can do so without risk. Apply cooling water to reduce the temperature of the tank and to prevent the tank from becoming a gas cylinder. Do not use water on the fire. Do not use water on the fire. Do not use water on the fire.

SPILL OR LEAK

Stop all ignition sources in the area and remove from the area. Do not walk or stand through spilled material. Only look if you can see it without risk. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and protective clothing. Only trained and equipped personnel should attempt.

Small spills:

If you can do so without risk, stop the spill with sand or other non-combustible absorbent material, and then remove it to a safe place for disposal or containment. Do not use water on the spill.

Large spills:

Evacuate the area and without risk, stop the spill with sand or other non-combustible absorbent material, and then remove it to a safe place for disposal or containment.

PRETARD

Wear water to block or limit the emergency material from the area. Do not walk or stand through spilled material. Only look if you can see it without risk. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and protective clothing. Only trained and equipped personnel should attempt.
