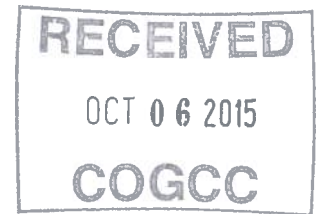

Rule Engineering, LLC is submitting the 2014 Annual Report for the above referenced facility on behalf of Encana Oil and Gas (USA), Inc. (Encana) for the North Parachute Ranch (NPR) Solidification Facility (NSF). The Form 28 was approved by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) in a letter dated July 11, 2012. The APEN with the CDPHE was approved on October 11, 2012 and after construction of the facility per the Form 28, operations began on November 6, 2012.


This report covers the period from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014. The waste processed at this facility during this period were estimated to include Frac Tank Bottoms of 888 cubic yards of solids and 4,566 barrels of liquid, Produced Water Tank Bottoms of 515 cubic yards of solids and 3,408 barrels of liquid, and Pit Bottoms of 202 cubic yards of solids and 1,610 barrels of liquid. After solidification with sawdust an estimated total of 2,333 cubic yards were transported for disposal at ECDC Environmental LLC in East Carbon, Utah.

There have been no spills or upsets at the NSF during this period

Surface water and groundwater monitoring are conducted on a regular basis at the locations identified in the Form 28 application for this facility. There were no significant changes observed and no petroleum hydrocarbons were detected.
