Dear Kelly,

Thank you for discussing the NOT for Permit #CO-0048712, Lone Pine Discharge permit.

CM Production operates the Lone Pine Oil Field which was previously operated by Lone Pine Gas, Inc., and ceased discharge of water from the production facility on October 31, 2014 in compliance with the CDPHE

requirements. CM Production submitted an NOT to Kelly Morgan June 18, 2014 by certified mail. I understand that you just recently received a request to investigate the NOT and determine if the Permit can be closed with or without a field visit and that this process normally takes approximately 2 months from the date you receive the investigation request.

CM Production would greatly appreciate your investigation of our NOT could be expedited, as CM continues to be required by the CDPHE to submit monthly DMRs by a certified professional stating "no discharge" which costs CM an unnecessary expenditure of \$1,000/month, not including CM Production Staff time, or \$10,000 for the past 10 months of reporting.

Attached is my contact information. I would appreciate being updated on the progress of your investigation. Also, please forward your contact information as I have only partial contact information.
