KERR-MCGEE OIL & GAS ONSHORE LP (KERR-MCGEE) HAS CLOSED THE RESERVE PIT USED TO DRILL THE SEC FOUR 4-4 WELL. THE RESERVE PIT WAS LOCATED ON THE SEC FOUR 18-4 WELL PAD SITE. A BACKGROUND SOIL SAMPLE (RBPBG01) WAS COLLECTED FROM THE BASE OF THE RESERVE PIT PRIOR TO THE PIT BEING UTILIZED FOR DRILLING ACTIVITIES. RBPBG01 WAS SUBMITTED FOR LABORATORY ANALYSIS OF TPH, BTEX, PH, EC AND TABLE 910-1 METALS. UPON COMPLETION OF THE DRILLING ACTIVITIES, THE DRILL MUD WAS REMOVED FROM THE RESERVE PIT AND EITHER RECYCLED OR LAND APPLIED. A CONFIRMATORY SOIL SAMPLE (RBPBG02) WAS COLLECTED FROM THE BASE OF THE EMPTIED RESERVE PIT AND SUBMITTED FOR LABORATORY ANALYSIS OF THE ABOVE LISTED ANALYTES. LABORATORY RESULTS CONFIRM THAT ALL ANALYTE LEVELS WERE WITHIN COGCC ALLOWABLE LEVELS AND/OR BELOW THE BACKGROUND LEVELS DETECTED IN RBPBG01 WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ARSENIC, WHICH WAS DETECTED AT A CONCENTRATION OF 16.0 MG/KG. LABORATORY REPORTS ARE INCLUDED AS AN ATTACHMENT TO THIS FORM 4.

IN ORDER TO CHARACTERIZE THE NATURE OF THE ARSENIC, KERR-MCGEE HAS COLLECTED DRILL CUTTINGS SAMPLES AT VARIOUS DEPTHS FROM 46 PRODUCTION WELLS ACROSS THE GREATER WATTENBERG AREA; COLLECTED FOUR-POINT COMPOSITE SAMPLES OF DRILLING FLUIDS FROM 13 RESERVE PITS; AND COLLECTED 12 POST-INCORPORATION LAND APPLICATION SAMPLES ALL OF WHICH WERE ANALYZED FOR TCLP ARSENIC. THE ANALYTICAL RESULTS DETERMINED THAT ALL DRILL CUTTINGS, DRILLING FLUID, AND POST-INCORPORATION SAMPLES DID NOT EXCEED THE RESPECTIVE TCLP LABORATORY METHOD DETECTION LIMITS. THE TCLP ANALYTICAL RESULTS ARE PROVIDED IN TABLE 1.

BASED UPON THESE RESULTS, KERR-MCGEE CONCLUDES THAT THE ARSENIC PRESENT IS NOT LEACHABLE AND DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A THREAT TO ENTER GROUNDWATER; AND IS THEREFORE, NOT A DANGER TO PUBLIC HEALTH OR THE ENVIRONMENT. AS A RESULT, KERR-MCGEE IS REQUESTING A NO FURTHER ACTION (NFA) STATUS DETERMINATION FOR THE RESERVE PIT.
