Alex/Kris,

I have attached the February and May 2015 groundwater analytical results from the Walden Waterflood Facility (WWFF) site (Remediation #7037). Historically low groundwater table elevations resulted in a localized increase in hydrocarbon concentrations during the August 2015 sampling event.

Remediation Status

Following the successful air sparging/soil vapor extraction pilot test conducted in June 2015, BCEOC and LTE have refined the full scale AS/SVE system design. The full scale implementation will be budgeted for and initiated in Spring 2016. BCEOC will continue to monitor groundwater concentrations on a quarterly basis. This data will be used to finalize the system design prior to construction in Spring 2016.
