Windy Hill Water Operations, LLC (“Windy Hill”) is seeking a permit from the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (Commission) for the disposal of up to 25,000 barrels of Exploration and Production (E&P) waste water daily via one Class II underground injection control (UIC) well. The facility would fall under the Commission’s jurisdiction for the Proposed Satellite Water Disposal Facility and the Proposed Central Water Facility. The Commission would permit the project as a Commercial Disposal Well Facility with a Class II Dedicated Injection Well with an Aquifer Exemption. The proposed disposal well is an existing well that was previously permitted as a Class V UIC well through the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). A map of the well site is enclosed. Injection of the waste water would be into the non-potable, non-tributary J Sandstone formation which is located approximately 5,100 feet below the surface.

The guiding rules and regulations for notice of this pending application are included in the Commission’s 300 Series Rules, Rule 325i., effective January 30, 2015, and, specifically for the purpose of this Notice, CRS 34-60-103(7). You are receiving this Notice since you, or an entity which you represent, have record ownership of a prior surface or mineral right within a one-quarter (1/4) mile radius of the proposed well site.

In accordance with Rule 325.I., if you state that you would be directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the authorization of the underground disposal into the J Sandstone injection zone, you may file, within 15 days of notification, a written request for a public hearing before the Commission, provided such request meets the protest requirements specified in subparagraph m. of Rule 325.


