Kris/Alex,

I just submitted a Sundry Form 4 to request modifying the sampling schedule at the Walden Water Flood Facility release location (Doc 400933334). Though we have never laid out a formal sampling schedule, I thought it was worth requesting that we be able to modify the schedule during the remainder of the remediation project. The quarterly sampling data is stable or steadily declining. The routine sampling events are costly due to the remote nature and number of wells requiring sampling and documentation. Sampling events require two days and per diem to complete.

The sundry details the reasoning and proposed future sampling schedule. We would prefer to change the sampling schedule for the upcoming sampling event this Thursday (11/12/15). I apologize for the short notice. However, we would greatly appreciate your review and approval prior to our sampling event.
