- 2) Control well with kill fluid.
- 3) POOH 2 3/8" tubing, Visually inspecting on the way out. Replace bad joints as needed. If more than 80 total joints fail, please contact engineer (720-417-1253) as scope of work might change.
- 4) RIH w/ Bit & Scraper. Tag fill if any. Clean out to PBTD (tally in). TOOH.
- 5) RIH w/RBP. Set RBP @ +/-6912' spot 2 sx of sand on top of RBP. Test RBP 2,000psi. TOOH.
- 6) Bleed off bradenhead, unland casing.
- 7) RIH with 1 1/4" down annulus as far as possible to TOC ~2635'
- 8) Condition hole.
- 9) Pump cement to +/-1250' (~385 sx).
- 10) POOH with workstring.
- 11) Re-land casing.
- 13) Clean out hole, retrieve RBP at 6912'. POOH.
- 14) RIH with 2 3/8" tubing, hydro testing, to 7111'. Replace bad joints as needed. If more than 80 total joints fail, please contact engineer (720-417-1253) as scope of work might change.
- 15) RDMO. RWTP. Run CBL the day after cementing.
