Lease Operator arrived on the Probe 24-35 location and found a cracked valve at the well head. It appears that freeze may have caused the valve to brake. The operator isolated upon discovery and is estimated that 15bbbls of prduced water were spilled. The spill did leave location and ran about 284' with No State Waters involved. Plans for repair and investigation will follow.
