SE Corner Coordinates (WGS84: 40.81769, -107.92225, Dennis said this is equivalent to NAD83 for our purposes)

- Pit located on north side of well
- Approximate dimensions: 18 feet N-S by 36 feet E-W at ground level and 10 feet N-S by 20 feet E-W at the bottom of the pit
- Depth is approximately 4 feet from bottom of pit to top of berm
- Lined with reinforced HDPE
- No apparent anchor trench, but berms placed on top of liner at surface
- Surrounded by 12-foot wide panel fencing (two panels on short ends of pit and four panels on long sides of pit)
- Jay's note from 6/16: There is a "bathtub line" on the plastic which indicated a recent 3' high fluid top, but now is mostly mud and less than 1' deep.
