Good morning Arthur!

Happy Monday! Can you believe the Broncos!?! What a game, my heart rate is still through the roof. Please see attached sundry figures. The 0.5 mile radius of the southern wells kiss up against the western quarter quarters of section 21 so I included information on the wells there also for you. Many of these well were old monitoring wells. When we were out there for the first time in 2014 I drove around and looked for them but they were nowhere to be found. You can tell that the area was previously irrigated (both in aerial photos and on the ground), the Anschutz ranch manager who toured me around all their active water wells said that he has never known of irrigation in the area, it's pretty sparse and sandy out there. I looked around the area for Permit 81436- - while I was out there as it was the best sample option in the area and I found some old scrap metal that looked like it may have been a windmill buried in the sand. Let me know if you want any pictures, I will have someone in the area doing stormwater early next week and he could snap a few on the ground shots. We have a really good relationship with these landowners so if you need anything additional just let me know.
