This email is in response to your voicemail question regarding what actions are required as a result of inspection number 685100013. The following is taken directly from the field inspection report....

- E&P waste should be stored per rule 907; in a way that prevents migration of soil or water that was in contact with E&P waste, to migrate from it's storage location. E&P waste berms, shall not be constructed of material that was treated as a part of this project.
- Fencing should prevent unintended entry to pit.
