Extraction Oil & Gas, LLC (Extraction) is planning to drill the following 12 horizontal wells:

Seltzer 2: Doc. #400924010 ; Seltzer 8: Doc. #400924049 ;
Seltzer 3: Doc. #400924014 ; Seltzer 9: Doc. #400924053 ;
Seltzer 4: Doc. #400924021 ; Seltzer 10: Doc. #400924065 ;
Seltzer 5: Doc. #400924024 ; Seltzer 11: Doc. #400924076 ;
Seltzer 6: Doc. #400924034 ; Seltzer 12: Doc. #400924085

The surface locations of Extraction's proposed wells have been staked outside of the COGCC Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window. Under the COGCC Rule 318A.c. any new twinning well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. The proposed Extraction wells listed above are not within 50 ft of an existing well. Extraction has received a waiver from the Surface owner which is attached to the APD.

Extraction respectfully requests the COGCC to review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location to rule 318A.a & 318A.c. for the Applications for Permits to Drill for the wells on the subject pad. This is the best location for the wells since it is on an existing pad.
