Paul and Phil,

Based on the data submitted, yhe record of the spill has been moved to closed in the COGCC database and the the request for no further actions is approved based on the data submitted in the form 27 now approved as project 9558 and attached.

Based on review of information presented it appears that no further action is necessary at this time. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.

That's prompts the next question... Form 27 status for the subject site? We have a draft of it for our review, and anticipate getting it to you in the next several days.

Not sure if we've had this conversation with you or not... It's not news to you that we have some outstanding Form 27s. Beginning in early 2015 we have requested that our consultants send us draft Form 27s such that we can get them submitted to COGCC within 90 days of the spill date. I think we have been successful with that effort. In the meantime, we are working on the backlog of what is owed to COGCC pre-2015.
