Attached is the conditionally approved Form 27 for the above referenced site. I changed the Facility ID of the oil skim pit to #117723.

In addition to the proposed remedial actions, the following conditions of approval will apply:

- Collect confirmation soil samples from the four sidewalls and base of the excavation for BTEX, TPH, pH and EC laboratory analysis.
- Collect confirmation soil samples from the four sides of the excavation at the surface to ensure that pH, EC and SAR are below Table 910-1 allowable levels.
- Provide a brief summary report of the excavation including soil sample results and waste disposal manifests to rob.young@state.co.us.
- Actively manage any landfarmed soil and collect soil samples (BTEX and TPH analysis) and report soil sample treatment results semi annually (March 31 and Oct 31). The soil samples should be collected from each 100 cubic yards of soil approximately. The soil treatment dates and any amendments or water applications should be included in the reports.
