Dene, Butch, and Rick,

Attached is the latest analytical report from the confirmation samples obtained from treated soil at the FTC Battery. I have also attached the updated analytical table. All six samples obtained on 6/30/16 came back below 500 mg/kg for DRO and non-detect for BTEX. BTEX was ran due to an error by the lab and we were not charged for it. These results mean piles B1 through B6 are ready to go back into the hole. Today, I obtained 10 more confirmation samples. I will run those with standard turnaround time and let you know when I receive the results. The untreated pile is getting much smaller and I believe we only have a week or so left of shredding. Let me know if you have any questions.
