Mr. Fritzler,

The above referenced Form 27 (Remediation Project #9400) has been approved with the following conditions:

1. Remove all loose soil from the open excavation and excavate visually impacted soils. Collect a minimum of one discreet soil confirmation sample from each of the sidewalls (cardinal directions) and a minimum of one soil sample from the base of the excavation for BTEX and TPH laboratory analysis. Collect the soil samples from the areas most likely to have been impacted.
2. Sample shallow soil at the edge of the excavation (approximate cardinal direction) for pH, EC and SAR in order to ensure that produced water impacted soils have been sufficiently removed or are covered by a minimum of three feet of clean cover fill.
3. Photograph the open excavation showing sidewalls, base and soil sample locations.
4. Submit a brief report of the oil skim pit remediation activities to COGCC ([rob.young@state.co.us](mailto:rob.young@state.co.us)) including a description of excavation activities, a soil sample summary table, photographs, soil disposal manifests, location figure showing excavation extent and soil sample locations and depths.
5. Provide a plan for landfarming the oily waste including semi-annual sampling and reporting, documentation of amendment type, quantity and frequency and planned tilling frequency. Please note that if the landfarm soil does not meet the Table 910-1 allowable concentrations by December 15, 2018, the soils shall be required to be removed and properly disposed off site.
