Encana and Hunter Ridge contacted the COGCC last month (June, 2016) to report a release of condensate from a pipeline near the A27 Centralized Distribution Point (A27 CDP). The condensate impacted soil and water mostly in your property but also in Mr. Bishop's property. As one of the Environmental Protection Specialists responsible for environmental compliance in the Northwest region of the State, I have been following up the emergency activities, the Site Assessment and will be providing regulatory oversight of remediation activities. I am regularly in contact with Encana/Hunter Ridge environmental team and they keep me informed of the environmental activities at the Site.
