Drilling/Completion Operations	604c.(2).K. Pit Level Indicators: All tanks (used in lieu of pits) contain pit level monitors with Electronic Drilling Recorders (EDR). KMG uses EDRs with pit level monitor(s) and alarm(s) for production rigs. Basic level gages are used on tanks utilized for the surface rig.
Drilling/Completion Operations	604c.(2).I. BOPE Testing for Drilling Operations: Upon initial rig-up, BOPEs will be tested at a minimum of every 30 days.
General Housekeeping	604c.(2).P. Removal of Surface Trash: A commercial size trash bin for removing debris will be located on site. This bin will be for use by all parties affiliated with the operation.
Final Reclamation	604c.(2).U. Identification of Plugged and Abandoned Wells: Pursuant to rule 319.a.(5)., once the well has been plugged and abandoned, KMG will identify the location of the wellbore with a permanent monument that will detail the well name and date of plugging.

Community Outreach and Notification	<p>An offset property owner within 1,000' of this oil and gas location expressed concerns regarding noise, light, traffic and dust in relation to our operations. KMG commits to the following BMPs to mitigate the concerns.</p> <p>Dust: KMG will apply magnesium chloride to roads to alleviate dust. The offset property owner expressed concern over utilizing water to abate dust due to the mud it can create.</p> <p>Light: The offset property owner's concerns regarding light were primarily focused on lights from truck traffic. KMG offered to place hay bales anywhere feasible along the offset owner's property to block light associated with the project. The residence sits atop a hill, so the hay bales would be most effective placed near the residence or atop the hill. The hay bales will be installed by KMG at request of the offset property owner.</p> <p>Noise: KMG will place hay bales on along the southern, south-western and eastern sides of the pad location to damper noise during drilling and completions. The additional hay bales mentioned in the light BMP above will also help alleviate noise associated with this project, if the offset property owner chooses to have them installed.</p> <p>Traffic: Truck traffic will access the location using WCR 19 and WCR 10. This traffic route was worked out with the offset property owner. Oil will be piped instead of transported by truck from this oil and gas location to greatly reduce the traffic associated with this project. Water will also be piped to further reduce traffic.</p>
Planning	<p>604c.(2).S. Access Roads: KMG will utilize a lease access road from Weld County Road 10 for drilling operations and maintenance equipment. The road will be properly constructed and maintained to accommodate for local emergency vehicle access.</p> <p>Magnesium chloride will be used as needed on access roads to further abate dust.</p>
Final Reclamation	<p>604c.(2).T. Well Site Cleared: The wellsite will be cleared of all non-essential equipment within ninety (90) days after all wells associated with the pad have been plugged and abandoned.</p>
Drilling/Completion Operations	<p>604c.(2).H. BOPE: Our rigs at a minimum will have a double ram with blind and pipe ram; and annular preventer.</p>
Planning	<p>604c.(2).V. Development From Existing Well Pads: KMG will locate the three proposed horizontal wells on the existing well pad with Location ID # 318806 to reduce the amount of surface disturbance.</p>
Drilling/Completion Operations	<p>604c.(2).L. Drill Stem Tests: No drill stem tests are planned and none will be performed without prior approval from the Director.</p>
Construction	<p>604c.(2).M. Fencing Requirements: The completed wellsites will be surrounded with a fence and gate with adequate lock to restrict access to authorized personnel only. KMG personnel will monitor the wellsites regularly upon completion of the wells. Authorized representatives and/or KMG personnel shall be on-site during drilling and completion operations.</p>
Noise mitigation	<p>604c.(2).A. Noise: Sound mitigation barriers (hay bales) will be placed along the southern, southwestern and eastern sides of the pad location to damper noise during drilling and completions to the nearby residences and to Weld County Roads 10 and 19.</p> <p>Sound surveys that have been conducted on each rig type are utilized to anticipate any additional noise mitigation once a drilling rig is determined.</p>
Planning	<p>604c.(2).R. Tank Specifications: Two 500 barrel skid-mounted frac tanks will be temporarily placed on-site for use of the pre-spud rig only. One tank will store water and the other will store water based mud.</p>
Planning	<p>604c.(2).Q. Guy Line Anchors: Should guy line anchors be left buried for future use, they shall be identified by a bright marker greater than four (4) feet high and no more than one (1) foot east of the guy line anchor.</p>
Traffic control	<p>604c.(2).D. Traffic Plan: If required by the local government, a traffic plan will be coordinated with the local jurisdiction prior to commencement of operations.</p>
Planning	<p>604c.(2).E. Multiwell Pads: In order to reduce surface impact, this application is for a three-well pad.</p>
Drilling/Completion Operations	<p>604c.(2).B. Closed Loop Drilling System: KMG will use a closed loop or "pitless" system for drilling and fluid management and will not construct a reserve pit.</p>
Material Handling and Spill Prevention	<p>604c.(2).N. Control of Fire Hazards: KMG and its contractors will employ best management practices during the drilling and production of its wells and facilities and will comply with appropriate COGCC rules concerning safety and fire. KMG will ensure that any material that might be deemed a fire hazard will remain no less than twenty-five (25) feet from the wellhead(s), tanks and separator(s).</p>
General Housekeeping	<p>604c.(2).O. Loadlines: All loadlines shall be bullplugged or capped.</p>

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Material Handling and Spill Prevention	604c.(2).W. Site-Specific Measures: KMG maintains a Stormwater Management Plan that assesses erosion control for every KMG operated location. This well pad will be added to this plan once construction begins. This plan is updated every fourteen (14) days and after any major weather event.
Construction	604c.(2).G. Berm Construction: Kerr-McGee will create tertiary containment by construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to further protect the ditch located 289' southwest of the oil and gas location.
Drilling/Completion Operations	604c.(2).J. BOPE for Well Servicing Operations: Blowout prevention equipment will be used on any servicing operations associated with this well. Backup stabbing valves will be used during any future servicing operations during reverse circulation. Valves shall be pressure tested before each well servicing operation using low-pressure air and high-pressure fluid.
