Diana-

We had issues on the Winder 5 with Carlisle exposure. Once again, targets were dictated by the well to the north we just drilled. We exposed the Carlisle and things looked good so we drilled another 1500'. However we tripped for a BHA change and when we got back to in the hole, the Carlisle had sloughed and we haven't had great success cleaning it up or getting through it without the hole grabbing us.

With your permission, we would like to pull back to 11,033' and sidetrack this will allow us to change our targets and stay in zone avoiding the shale.
