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The COGCC has reviewed the NFA** request for remediation #7952. Based on the information presented, no further action is necessary at this time. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.

As presented in the Form 27 Supplement and Request for No Further Action (see document #2210688), additional confirmation soil sampling was conducted per the COAs and sample results indicate that the remaining hydrocarbon concentrations in soil are below the COGCC Table 910-1 concentration levels. COGCC concurs that no further action is necessary at this time. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be impacted, further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site. Note that surface reclamation must meet the COGCC 1004 series rules.
