Dear Mr. Burger:

Gulfport Energy Corporation is requesting approval from the CDPHE to flare gas from the Meeker 1-4 well located in the NS SE Section 4, T1N, R9W, Rio Blanco County, Colorado. The well was producing 145 MCFD in and have around 130 MCFD to sale or flare in Dec 2015. The well has been shut-in since January 2016 with no plans to turn online in the near future. The closest pipeline is 3000 feet and is estimated to cost \$960,000 to install pipeline. At this current volume of gas, it does not economically justify constructing facilities and a gathering line to move the gas to sales. We request approval to flare gas until gas prices improve, or economics change, to install a gathering system that would be economically viable. We will look into these options over the next year and provide an update on next year's annual sundry update.
