Extraction Oil & Gas, LLC (Extraction) is planning to drill the following horizontal wells:

Kiteley 1: (Doc # 401093162), Kiteley 7: (Doc # 401093194),  
Kiteley 2: (Doc # 401093165), Kiteley 8: (Doc # 401093198),  
Kiteley 3: (Doc # 401093168), Kiteley 9: (Doc # 401093216),  
Kiteley 4: (Doc # 401093171), Kiteley 10: (Doc # 401093224),  
Kiteley 5: (Doc # 401093185), Kiteley 11: (Doc # 401093226),  
Kiteley 6: (Doc # 401093190), Kiteley 12: (Doc # 401093228),

The surface locations of Extraction's proposed wells have been staked outside of the COGCC Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window. Under the COGCC Rule 318A.c. any new twinning well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. The proposed Extraction wells listed above are not within 50 ft of an existing well. The surface owner has waived Rules 318A.a. & 318A.c. in the SUA which is highlighted on p.5 of the SUA attached to the APD.

Extraction respectfully requests the COGCC to review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location to rule 318A.a & 318A.c. for the Applications for Permits to Drill for the wells on the subject pad. This is the best location since it will keep the wells as far away as possible from building units.
