Good morning,

The Duncan Ranch well (API# 05-081-07799-00) has been shut-in for the winter. They are out there today securing the location for the winter. Late last week the drill cuttings were sampled. Those samples along with background samples from the proposed burial area were forwarded to ACZ Labs in Steamboat Springs for Table 910-1 analyses. I'll get them to you in a sundry notice requesting permission to bury the cuttings as soon as we receive the results.

State and federal APDs have been submitted for a lateral well off of the existing vertical Duncan Ranch well. Current plans call for moving the rig to the location in early June 2017 with kickoff by mid-June. I'll keep you posted. I sent an email update to Jeff Comstock a few minutes ago.
