Erin,

In reviewing records associated with an asset transfer from Encana to Crestone Peak, COGCC has identified a pit record for which we need information from Extraction.

The Miller 14-17 well (API 05-123-07960) was plugged by Extraction in 2014. The well shared a Location (Location ID #333209) with Encana's Miller 14-17J well (API 05-123-11601). The original tank battery and production facilities associated with 123-07960 included a 20x20x8 production pit (Pit Facility 103309). Based on COGIS aerial and Google Earth images, it appears the pit was closed sometime between 1999 and 2003. However, the pit record was not closed, and therefore the "asset" was transferred along with the well from Machii-Ross to Sundance in 2012 and from Sundance to Extraction in 2014.

Since the pit is mapped in COGCC's COGIS system based on the center of the quarter-quarter section, and it is clearly visible on the 1999 aerial imagery, I will administratively enter a lat/lon to move the pit record based on the southeast corner of the visible pit. The lat/lon will be 40.13308, -104.921035.



From Extraction, I need a request to administratively close the pit. It would help if you could include any records you may have of a physical closure (AFE, invoices, etc) from the time it was closed. In the absence of any records in your files for the well, a statement from Extraction indicating the known history of the pit and that the pit was never in existence or operated while Extraction operated the well would be very helpful. If it is known when the pit was closed, it will be easier to know what pit closure rules applied at that time, to ensure that pit was properly closed.

COGCC records do not indicate a connection between this pit and the Encana well.
