Jim,

This spill report is provided as a courtesy of Red Willow.

Red Willow discovered a release Friday October 14, 2016, at the 34-9 #31-12 FC well. The estimated spill volume is 23.5 BBL of produced water. This estimate is from change in water production from Cygnet, Red Willow's automation program. The release occurred due to a split/hole in the flow line from the well head to the separator. The release did not leave the pad. It left a pool of water next to the separator that was too small to recover with a vacuum-truck. The well was shut-in and an emergency one-call was placed so that repairs can be made. This release occurred on the well pad and therefore no sampling was done.

Red Willow proposes no further action.

Attached are the spill report and photographs.
