This Warning Letter is to inform you that BLUE CHIP OIL INC (“Operator”) may be in violation of the rules and regulations of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (“COGCC”) and corrective action is required.

The COGCC has reasonable cause to believe that the Operator has committed one or more violations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, or of a rule, regulation, or order of the Commission, or of a permit issued by the Commission. The Operator is required to comply with this Warning Letter by the **Corrective Action Deadline Date(s)** to resolve the alleged violation(s). Failure to do so will result in the issuance of a Notice of Alleged Violation and initiation of enforcement proceedings in which COGCC will seek monetary penalties for the alleged violations pursuant to § 34-60-121, C.R.S. and Rule 523, COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1.

Alleged Violation(s) and Required Corrective Action(s):

906.b Spill Reporting

Description of Alleged Violation: Pursuant to Rule 906.b., Blue Chip Oil Inc (Operator) is required to notify the designated local government agent not more than 24 hours after discovery of a reportable spill/release and submit a Form 19, Supplemental Spill/Release Report, not more than 10 calendar days after discovery of a reportable spill/release. On August 3, 2016, Operator discovered a reportable release at NWNW Sec 20, T1S, R67W in Adams County, Colorado (Spill/Release #447264). The release was timely reported to COGCC staff COGCC staff and a Form 19, Initial Spill/Release Report, (Document #401088702) was submitted on August 3, 2016. However, the designated local government agent was never contacted and the Form 19, Supplemental Spill/Release Report, (Document #401104993) was not submitted until October 5, 2016, violating Rule 906.b.

Required Corrective Action: Operator has already reviewed the requirements of this rule with COGCC staff and no further corrective action is required at this time. Operator is not required to respond to this letter or submit evidence of completed Corrective Actions.

Corrective Action Deadline Date: 11/30/2016
