Hi Peter – here's the email we sent to Chris Canfield that included the 3rd Quarter 2016 GW Report.

As indicated in that report, we had two clean consecutive quarters, however, our most recent sampling event for the 4TH Quarter 2016 indicated that we've had a bit of rebound in MW-1 and MW-5, which had benzene concentrations of 7.4 and 40 ug/L, respectively. We have had the AS/SVE unit off since approximately May 2016.

The 4th Quarter report will be issued in the next week or two. I will email it to you directly at that time.
