Alma (20) HZ wells: SWSE, Section 25, Township 1 South, Range 66 West, Weld County, CO

Dear Mr. Lepore:

HRM Resources II, LLC (HRM) is planning to drill the following 20 horizontal wells:

Alma 1NH, Alma 2NH, Alma 3CDH, Alma 4NH, Alma 5NH, Alma 6NH, Alma 7CDH, Alma 8NH, Alma 9NH,  
Alma 10CDH, Alma 11NH, Alma 12NH, Alma 13NH, Alma 14CDH, Alma 15NH, Alma 16NH, Alma 17CDH,  
Alma 18NH, Alma 19NH & Alma 20CDH.

The surface locations of HRM's proposed wells have been staked outside of the COGCC Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window. Under the COGCC Rule 318A.c. any new twinning well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. The proposed HRM wells listed above are not within 50 ft of an existing well. The surface owner has waived Rules 318A.a. & 318A.c. in the SUA on p.2, Item # 1.2 which is attached to each APD.

HRM respectfully requests the COGCC to review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location to rule 318A.a & 318A.c. for the Applications for Permits to Drill for the wells on the subject pad. This is the best location for the wells and facility to keep the greatest distance from the surrounding building units at well over 1000'.
