Discovered during routine inspections. Former Gas Plant site operated as early as 1958. One surface structure remains at site as well as concrete blocks and pads, piping, anchor posts and one pit. No environmental impacts are evident.

Proposed Work _____

Work will include removal of all concrete, piping and anchor posts and on site burial pending landowner approval. The remaining building will be demolished and the resulting debris will be recycled, hauled offsite for appropriate disposal or, if properly permitted, burned on site as appropriate. All disturbed areas will be fine graded to match existing topography. Site will be revegetated to match existing conditions.
