Re: Little Hoot Water Well Results

Dear Mr. Fogale,

Please find enclosed a copy of the laboratory report for the water sample collected from the water well at the former Little Hoot Gas Plant site on April 19, 2007. The sample was collected to screen for possible impacts to groundwater that may have originated from the historic gas plant. Based on the results, there are no apparent impacts to groundwater from the former gas plant.

Also enclosed is an informational brochure that includes a section on water quality standards and interpretation. The brochure was published for water wells in southwest Colorado, but provides good general information regardless of location.

The Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) intends to complete reclamation at the Little Hoot site later in 2007, depending on available funding. Additional work will include demolition of the remaining structure, on-site burial of concrete, grading and revegetation.
