Discovered during routine inspections. Former Gas Plant site operated as early as 1958. All surface structures have been removed. There are no environmental impacts evident. Several concrete blocks, pipes and anchor posts remain at the site.

Proposed Work _____
Work will include removal and proper sizing for off site disposal of remaining concrete, pipes and anchor posts. Land owner requested that nothing be buried on site. Debris will be transported to the solid waste landfill in Sterling, CO. All disturbed areas will be fine graded to match existing topography. Site will be revegetated to match existing conditions.
