Mr. Smith,

The above referenced Form 27 has been approved with the following conditions:

1. Submit a site sketch of the spill (sediment deposition) area showing the soil sample location(s).
2. In addition to the soil sampling, a best management practice (BMP) for controlling the erosion of soil off of the produced water pit berms should be installed. The berm material that has washed off of the pit berms onto the surrounding crop land shall be scraped up and placed back onto the existing pit berms. Soil samples shall be collected after removal of the eroded berm material to confirm compliance with Table 910-1 allowable levels of pH, EC and SAR on the affected crop land.
3. Email the soil sample laboratory data and photographs of the location documenting removal of the eroded soil and installation of effective erosion control BMPs to rob.young@state.co.us.
