Mr. Croom:

Noble Energy Inc. ("Noble") plans to drill the Centennial State G34-689 Well (the "Well"), with a wellbore lateral as depicted on the enclosed plat.

Our records indicate that Crestone Peak Resources Operating, LLC. ("Crestone") operates the following well(s) which may be located within 150' from our proposed horizontal wellbore lateral:

**Lisback 4-8-27
Beebe Draw 2-8-26**

Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC") Rule 317(s) provides that no portion of a proposed wellbore's treated interval shall be located less than one hundred fifty (150') feet from any existing or permitted oil or gas wellbore, but this requirement may be waived in writing by the operator of the encroached upon well.

Noble respectfully requests that Crestone waive this requirement and allow Noble to drill the Well as proposed. Accordingly, by executing this letter, Crestone waives COGCC Rule 317(s) and grants its consent to allow Noble to drill the Well within the 150' minimum intra-well distance provided for in said rule.
