General Comment:

COGCC environmental staff inspection. COGCC field inspector inspection and flowline integrity staff inspection (#674603227, #685502288). Spill release point leak from a 2-inch flowline in drainage. Fluids daylighted and flowed approximately 900 feet downstream to north. Some minor surface water ponding located from just north of the release location excavation to approximately 300 feet downstream. Remaining drainage is dry. Clean-up to date consisting of removal of impacted surface soils in drainage. Fluid in release location excavation is groundwater which is periodically removed and transported to HRM's injection facility for disposal. See photos (attached)

Comment: Spill #401234377 reported from a flowline leak on 3/15/17. Approximately 3- to 5-bbls of fluid (produced water and crude oil) released from a corroded flowline into Horse Creek, an intermittent drainage. Horse Creek did not have any live water drainage at the time of the spill. Operator actively engaged in clean-up actions as soon as discovered and ongoing clean-up actions observed during inspection. COGCC notified CDPHE per MOA on 3/16/17.
