Dear Ms. Peterson,

Bill Barrett Corporation (“BBC”) is planning to drill oil wells from two pads that will be placed in the N/2 of the NE of Section 30, T5N-R63W. Production facilities for these pads will be located in the SWNE of Section 30 and within a Buffer Zone. Rule 305.a(2) of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission’s (“COGCC”) Rules and Regulations requires that BBC provide a “Notice of Intent to Conduct Oil and Gas Operations” to all Surface Owners and Building Unit Owners within the 1,000 foot Buffer Zone. A recent field survey indicates that your residence (i.e., Building Unit) is located approximately 750 feet from BBC’s proposed Peterson 5-63-30_31 SWNE Production Pad. You may request a meeting to discuss the proposed operations by contacting the LGD or Operator (BBC).

A notice of Comment Period will be sent pursuant to Rule 305.c(2) when the public comment period commences.
