Regarding the above referenced warning letter:

Alleged Violation(s) and Required Actions(3)

Rule 308B Completed Interval Report.

Review of Laramie records indicate all Form 5A's are up to date. The well was returned to production for one day in August, 2016 for test purposes then nine days in September, 2016, but no workover, re-“fracs”, or re-completes occurred.

Rule 309 Operator's Monthly Production Report.

Review of the Form 7's and the Production Reporting Data on the COGCC database indicates the well was shut-in until August, 2016 in which time the well was returned to production.

Rule 319.b Temporary Abandonment

Records indicate an MIT was conducted and approved 10-20-2011. A form 4 was applied for and approved 2/15/2013 for continued “shut-in” status.

Rule 326 Mechanical Integrity Testing

In preparation for conducting an MIT prior to 10-20-2016, Laramie received E-mail approval to effectively waive the MIT and put the well on line by OGCC engineer after his review of the casing, tubing, and bradenhead pressures recorded on the well 9-7-2016. Please see attached E-mail with pressures and approval by OGCC engineer.

Laramie believes the above explanation of each alleged violation adequately addresses WARNING LETTER #401227106 and the current status of the well.
