PDC WILL CONTINUE TO SAMPLE THE EIGHT MONITORING WELLS ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO ASSESS THE DISSOLVED PHASE PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON IMPACTS IN GROUNDWATER USING USEPA METHOD 8260. GROUNDWATER SAMPLING WILL CONTINUE UNTIL FOUR CONSECUTIVE QUARTERS OF GROUNDWATER MONITORING DATA INDICATE THAT BTEX CONCENTRATIONS ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE COGCC TABLE 910-1 GROUNDWATER STANDARDS.

Based on historic analytical results, PDC Energy is requesting a reduction in the quarterly monitoring well network. Monitoring wells BH07 and BH08 have exhibited fourteen or more quarters of constituent concentrations below COGCC Table 910-1 groundwater standards (Figure 2). Contingent on COGCC approval, removal of the selected monitoring wells would be conducted in the second quarter 2017.
