1	Traffic control	Speed restrictions will be posted.
2	Dust control	Magnesium chloride will be applied to the access road, and silica dust controls will be in place when handling sand used in hydraulic fracturing operations.
3	Noise mitigation	32' sound walls will be placed on three sides of location during drilling operations.
4	Odor mitigation	ConocoPhillips will use a closed loop system during drilling operations and drilling mud and all waste will be hauled off for disposal. The completions flowback is designed to be 100% closed loop to capture all flowback vapors. During production operations, a VRU will be used to help capture VOC emissions.
5	Drilling/Completion Operations	Lighting shall be directed downward and inward and shielded so as to avoid glare on public roads and Building Units. 32' sound walls placed on three sides of location during drilling operations will further abate light pollution.
