INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

IN MAY 2007, HISTORICAL PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON SOIL WAS ENCOUNTERED WHILE TYING NEW WELLS INTO THE BATTERY. THE WELLS WERE SHUT IN AND PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON IMPACTED SOIL WAS EXCAVATED.

In November 2008, an operator left the production tank drain valve open to the water sump and left the site. Approximately 80 barrels of crude oil were released within the steel tank battery berm before the night operator arrived and closed the drain valve. A vacuum truck was used to recover 35 barrels of crude oil from inside the berm and the petroleum hydrocarbon impacted soil was excavated. The Site Map depicting the 2007 and 2008 excavations is attached as Figure 1.

APPROXIMATELY 363 CUBIC YARDS OF PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON IMPACTED SOIL WERE REMOVED FROM THE EXCAVATION. LABORATORY RESULTS INDICATE THAT TPH CONCENTRATIONS ARE BELOW THE COGCC ALLOWABLE LEVELS AT THE EXTENT OF THE EXCAVATION. A 5-GALLON MIXTURE OF MICROBLAZE WAS APPLIED TO THE GROUNDWATER AND EXPOSED SMEAR ZONES IN THE OPEN EXCAVATION.

Groundwater monitoring wells MW01R through MW04, MW07 through MW13, TMW01, TMW05, and TMW10 are sampled on a quarterly basis and submitted for laboratory analysis for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX) by United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Method 8260C. The monitoring well locations are depicted on Figure 1. The Groundwater Elevation Contour Map generated using the April 2017 survey data is provided as Figure 2. The groundwater analytical results are summarized in Table 1, and the laboratory analytical report for the April 2017 groundwater monitoring event is attached.

Groundwater and surface water monitoring will continue on a quarterly basis until a No Further Action status request is warranted.
