Dear Mr. Croom:

Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP is applying for permits to drill the captioned horizontal wells. Pursuant to Rule 317.r, you are being provided notice of three proposed wellbores lying within one hundred fifty (150) feet of the existing active wells cited below. Additionally, pursuant to Rule 317.s, no portion of a proposed wellbore's treated interval shall be located within one hundred fifty (150) feet of an existing (producing, shut-in, or temporarily abandoned) or permitted oil and gas wellbore's treated interval belonging to another operator without the signed written consent of the operator of the encroached upon wellbore.

As currently planned, the following wells operated by Crestone Peak Resources have treated intervals that lie within one hundred fifty (150) feet of the horizontal laterals of KMG's captioned wells:


