5/31/2017: RU wireline, PU 4-1/2" CIBP, TIH and set at 6,804', TOH
TIH and CDB 2 sxs of cement on top, TOH, RD wireline, RU hydro testers, TIH to 4,476'
Load and circulate wellbore clean, pressure test CIBP to 1000 psi. pressure held
Pump 50 sxs of cement, 10.24 bbl. of slurry, TOH
RU wireline, TIH and perforate casing at 2,500', TOH, RD wireline, shut well in, SDFN

6/1/2017: PU 4-1/2" CICR, TIH and set at 2,398', establish injection rate into CICR
Pump 210 sxs of cement (43.01 bbl. of slurry), 200 sxs under and 10 sxs on top
TOH, RU wireline, TIH and cut casing at 896', TOH, RD wireline
Circulate wellbore clean, NDWH, NDBOP, spear casing, unland casing, NUWH, NUBOP
Shut well in, SDFN

Pump 300 sxs of cement to surface, 61.5 bbl. of slurry from 949' to surface

6/5/2017: TOC at 4', shut well in with night cap, RDMO, P&A complete
