Corrective Action: Establish vegetation that consists of a non-invasive, uniform plant cover of at least eighty (80) percent of pre-disturbance or reference area levels throughout the disturbance area. Consult with the local Natural Resource Conservation Service on a seed mixture that matches the adjacent land or a seed mixture requested by the landowner. Ensure erosion controls are implemented to stabilize the seeded soil, and continue to monitor and manage this site until the location meets Rule 1004 standards. Final reclamation activities shall be complete no later than 5/31/2017.

Operator Comment: Operator has established vegetation of a non-invasive, uniform plant cover of at least 80% of predisturbance levels throughout the disturbance area using a seed mixture similar to the surrounding native lands. Operator ensures erosion controls to stabilize the seeded soil, and continues to monitor and manage the site until the location meets Rule 1004 standards.

COGCC Decision: Approved pending re-inspection

COGCC Representative: With respect to rules 1002.b and 1002.c within the Modular Large Volume Tank Policy, both cropland and non-cropland apply. Approved pending re-inspection of the FIR resolution acknowledges that the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission has received the Notice. It is not an acknowledgement that the corrective action has been passed. A field inspection will be conducted to evaluate compliance with COGCC standards.

OPERATOR COMMENT AND SUBMITTAL

Comment: With respect to 1002.b. & 1002.c, the tank was not set on cropland so soil was not graded and therefore not segregated. Since soil was not disturbed and segregated there was no stockpile to protect.
