Ms. Burn,

As per my voicemail, please see the e mail below detailing our plans to sidetrack the Kunsemiller 5-61-20-2417B2. Please let me know if you need any more information, thank you.

- We collided with the Kunsemiller 5-61-0108BH at 1637' MD and need to plug back and sidetrack to continue drilling.
- The total MD of the hole to be abandoned is 1656' MD.
- 9 5/8" surface casing is set at 818' MD.
- There is no fish in the hole.
- The proposed cement plug will run from 900' to 1600' MD.
- Sidetrack KOP is 900'MD.
- The objective formation for the sidetrack hole is the Niobrara formation, which is the same objective formation as the wellbore being abandoned.
- The PBHL of the sidetrack hole is the same as the wellbore being abandoned.

The “Application for Permit to Drill a Sidetrack Wellbore, Form 2” will be submitted end of next business day as per COGCC guidelines.
