

Response to July 27, 2017 Inspection (Document 675103757)
UPRR Noonan 3
Location ID 311681

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) conducted reclamation inspections at six Noble Energy, Inc. (Noble) locations within Adams County (location IDs 311698, 311664, 376781, 375675, 311680, 311681) on July 27 and 28, 2017. These sites were formerly owned, operated, abandoned, and reclaimed by Petro-Canada Resources USA, Inc. (PCR) prior to Noble's acquisition of PCR.

All six of these locations are on land owned by a single landowner, who has requested that we address all six sites at the same time to limit disturbance to his property. The landowner has also requested that no work be conducted during wet weather to limit impacts to his land. In addition, the landowner has site-specific requests for some of the locations that will be addressed through the landowner variance process.

The reclamation work will commence approximately two weeks after obtaining the necessary approvals and variances for all six sites. The active reclamation work for all six sites is estimated to take approximately one month to complete.

COGCC Corrective Action

Remove fence, submit FIRR with photo documentation showing fence has been removed to inspector.

Noble's Planned Response

Noble will remove the fence on this location. Because the post holes are larger than is typical, Noble will fill the post holes with topsoil.
