Crescent Point Energy U.S. Corp (Crescent Point) is planning to drill the above mentioned well(s) in the Niobrara and Codell formations.

The surface location of Crescent Point's proposed well(s) have been staked outside of the 318A.a drilling window. The location is being permitted as an exception location. Crescent Point has obtained written permission contained in a waiver from the surface owner.

Under rule 318A.c any new twinning well is to be located within 50' of an existing well. The surface location of Crescent Point's proposed **Colette 7-64-8-0263B** is staked is approximately 120' from the other proposed wells. Crescent Point has obtained permission, contained in a waiver, from the surface owner.

Crescent Point respectfully requests that the COGCC review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception location waiver and Application for Permit to Drill for the captioned wells.
