Hi Aaron,

Thanks for the email. I will be providing a response to six reclamation inspections (Location IDs: 311698, 311664, 376781, 375675, 311680, 311681). The deadline to respond is August 31<sup>st</sup>, and while Margaret indicated we should have active reclamation, stormwater controls, and remediation (where necessary) underway, these actions won't be complete by the deadline.

On the FIRR, I think the only options are to submit a factual dispute or to submit the action as complete. Because the actions are underway, but not complete, my question is to how we should submit a response. Do you want me to submit an FIRR as 'complete', a letter, or some other type of response?

Abby,

Based on the email conversations I had seen between Noble and Margaret, I believe the expectations were that work needs to begin no later than this date (8/31/2017).

Regarding the FIRR, A form 4 stating "final reclamation will commence by \_\_\_\_" will be more suitable, as a resolution stating "complete" would indicate that the corrective action has been addressed, completed and ready for re-inspection.

As Margaret had stated, in your response, please include details as to what reclamation activities, stormwater controls, remediation (if needed) are planned for the location. It would also be beneficial for me if you could include an estimated time line as to when certain projects are planned to begin (i.e when/what controls will be installed, construction, seeding, etc...)
