Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Extraction) is planning to drill the following well:

AD-Dairy C8-20-24 (Doc #401415942)

The surface location of Extraction's proposed well has been staked outside of the COGCC Rule 318A.a. Greater Wattenberg Area (GWA) Drilling Window. Under the COGCC Rule 318A.c. any new twinning well is to be located within 50 feet of an existing well. The proposed Extraction well listed above is not within 50 ft of an existing well. Extraction is the surface owner and self-waives Rules 318A.a. & 318A.c.

Extraction respectfully requests the COGCC to review the enclosed information and approve the requested exception to Rules 318A.a & 318A.c. for the Applications for Permits to Drill for the well. This is the best location for the well since Extraction wants to keep the well out of the floodway and 100 year floodplain as much as possible.
