Dear Mr. and Mrs. Medlin,

Great Western Operating Company, LLC ("Great Western") is applying to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC") to drill wells from the above-referenced surface location.

Rule 318A.a of the COGCC Rules and Regulations requires that wells drilled within the Greater Wattenberg Area (as defined therein) be drilled in a square with sides four hundred (400) feet in length, the center of which is the center of any governmental quarter/quarter section ("400' window"); or a square with sides eight hundred (800) feet in length, the center of which is the center of any governmental quarter section ("800' window").

Great Western will not locate all wells associated with the above-referenced surface location within the Greater Wattenberg Area windows. Instead, the wells will be placed within the above-referenced surface location in accordance with the Surface Use and Damage Agreement between Great Western and Wayne and Patricia Medlin.

Great Western respectfully requests that you waive the COGCC Rule 318A.a requirement so that the wells may be drilled as agreed upon.


